

ORDINANCE NO. 1997-5

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 290;
SETTING FORTH THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 290;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFORE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 6 of Ordinance 290 shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. In the event that the owner of any real property who is given notice or ordered to abate a condition pursuant to the provisions of this ordinance shall refuse to so comply with this order or notice in the period of time established for compliance by said order and shall not have filed an appeal, said owner shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined a minimum of \$100 for the first offense, and for each subsequent offense shall be fined a minimum of \$250."

SECTION 2. It being necessary for the preservation of the public, peace, health, and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
