APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 1999-1

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS: AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED: AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 1999-1 TO AMEND A PORTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 1998-21.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Ordinance establishing the salaries of certain city employees..

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the city council of the city of Ozark, to comply with applicable State Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND EXECUTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS:

That Ordinance No. 1998-21 is hereby amended to reflect the following changes:

SECTION 2: The salaries of city employees shall be:

Delete Starting Certified Police Officer - \$1566.00

SECTION 3. The following named individuals shall retain post payments of deferred compensation and shall continue to receive in the future, monthly deferred compensation in the amount set forth beside their name below:

The above stated individuals shall receive the sums set forth above each month in lieu of their life insurance premiums due to the fact that they have elected not to purchase life insurance with the City paying the premiums therefore.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall affect no provision of City of Ozark Ordinance No. 1998-21 except as provided herein.

SECTION 5. It is hereby found and declared by the Ozark City Council that an emergency exists requiring the immediate passage of this Ordinance. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
