ORDINANCE NO. 2001-7

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR REPAIRS TO WALKER STREET AND ALLEYWAY BETWEEN 3RD AND 4TH STREET; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFORE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS THAT:

I.

Arkansas Code Ann. 18-58-303 and City of Ozark Ordinance No. 1995-12 require competitive bidding, but allow the City Council by ordinance to waive competitive bidding in instances where it is not practical or feasible to accept bids.

Π.

The City Council deems it not practical nor feasible to advertise for and accept competitive bids for the repairs to Walker Street and Alleyway between 3rd and 4th Street. The City has received a quote from McCormick Asphalt Paving and Excavating, Inc. in the amount of \$8,240.00 for Walker St. and \$6,000.00 for Alleyway between 3rd and 4th for materials and labor for overlay or paving, totaling \$14,240.00. McCormick Asphalt Paving and Excavating, Inc. is able to perform repairs immediately as opposed to a much longer delay. In light of the detriment which would be placed upon the City to further delay street repairs and the impractical aspect of advertising for repairs, the Mayor should be and hereby is authorized to contract with McCormick Asphalt Paving and Excavating, Inc. to repair said streets.

III.

It being necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
