ORDINANCE NO. 2006- 24

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1994-23 OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to adjust rates to be charged for the services of the System in accordance with the requirements for the revenue bonds by amending Ordinance No.1993-6 of the City, adopted and approved May 4, 1993. ("Ordinance No. 1993-6")

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Ozark, Arkansas:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1993-6, 1994-16, 1994-22, and 1994-23 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That the following monthly rates and charges which the City council hereby finds and declares are fair, reasonable and minimum rates to be charged for sewer services be, and they are hereby fixed as rates to be charged for services rendered by the System.

All monthly sewer charges shall be based upon water consumption. The water usage of each customer shall be determined each month by meter measurement and the amount to be paid by each customer shall be computed on the basis of the following schedule of rates:

For the first 1,000 gallons of water consumption per month, or portion thereof

\$4.26 (minimum)

For the next 29,000 gallons of water consumption per month, or portion thereof

\$1.42 per 1,000 gallons

All over 30,000 gallons of water consumption per month, or portion thereof

\$.56 per 1,000 gallons

Section 2. Ordinance No. 1993-6, as amended hereby, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. That the new rates will apply to sewer bills rendered on and after January 1, 2007
Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
