AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE No. 1991-24 PROVIDING FOR A 5% TRANSFER FROM THE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF OZARK, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS THAT:

- 1. That the five percent (5%) transfer from the Water and Sewer Departments of the City of Ozark, Arkansas, to the City General Fund of the City of Ozark, Arkansas is hereby repealed as of January 1, 2009.
- 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 1991-_, 24

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A FIVE (5%) PERCENT TRANSFER FROM THE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS TO THE CITY GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That from and after the passage and approval of this Ordinance, there shall be a five (5%) percent transfer from the water and sewer department of the City of Ozark, Arkansas based upon their total receipts, to be paid each month into the general fund of the City of Ozark, Arkansas.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is passed pursuant to A.C.A. 14-200-101, and this Ordinance shall be deemed prima facie reasonable.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall become effective on the 1st day of January, 1992.

SECTION 4: All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5; Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be held void or invalid, for any reason, it shall not affect the validity of any other section or provision herein.

SECTION 6: An emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage.
