

ORDINANCE NO. 1997-22

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS:

WHEREAS, duties of certain elected officials and employees' services are required in carrying on the business and services of the City of Ozark, Arkansas:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND EXECUTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS,


SECTION 4.
