

ORDINANCE NO. 1999-25

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR USED TRASH TRUCK AND USED RECYCLING TRUCK; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFORE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS THAT:

I.

Arkansas Code Ann. §18-58-303 and City of Ozark Ordinance No. 1995-12 require competitive bidding, but allow the City Council by ordinance to waive competitive bidding in instances where it is not practical or feasible to accept bids.

II.

The City Council deems it not practical nor feasible to advertise for and accept competitive bids for the purchase of a used Heil rear-load trash truck and used Mack recycling truck. The City has received a quotes from Waste Management, Inc. in the amount of \$20,000.00 for the used trash tuck and \$10,000.00 for the use recycling truck. Waste Management, Inc. is able to supply the trucks immediately as opposed to a much longer delay. In light of the detriment which would be placed upon the City to further delay the delivery of a trash truck and a recycling truck and the impractical aspect of advertising for a specific or two specific used trash and recycling trucks, the Mayor should be and hereby is authorized to contract with Waste Management, Inc. to purchase said trucks.

III.


It being necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
