

ORDINANCE NO. 1999-7


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF OZARK ORDINANCE NO. 1998-22;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFORE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Section 1: Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Ozark that the budgeted disbursement for the purchase of a mini-pumper in the amount of \$40,000.00 shall be and hereby is transferred to a new budgeted disbursement item of "satellite fire station" in the amount of \$40,000.00.

Section 2: Additionally, the interest money earned on certificates of deposit set aside for fire truck purchase shall be and hereby are added to the specific new budgeted item of "satellite fire station" in the approximate sum of \$10,000.00.


Section 3: It be necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, health and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
