

ORDINANCE NO. 2008- 8

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING MANDATORY TRASH SERVICE PER RESIDENTIAL AND BUSINESS WATER METER, ESTABLISHING A MISDEMEANOR AND FINE FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The City of Ozark has entered into a contract for the collection and disposal of solid waste within the corporate limits of the City of Ozark, Arkansas;

SECTION 2: Trash pick-up shall be required for each residential water meter within the corporate limits of the City of Ozark;

SECTION 3: Each business water meter shall be required to have one of two options of either curb-side trash pick-up or a dumpster, as each need may arise;

SECTION 4: It is hereby declared unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, individual association or agent of any of the foregoing, anywhere within the City of Ozark, Arkansas to violate the provisions of the contract which the City has signed with D.C. Trash, Inc. or use said collection and disposal service and not comply with the terms of the Ordinance as to payment for said services;


SECTION 5: Any person, firm, corporation, individual association, or agent of any of them, who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance or any provisions of the contract which the City has signed with D.C. Trash, Inc. shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon issuance of a citation and conviction shall be fined not less than (\$25.00) nor more than (\$100.00) plus costs, and if such violations be continuing, each day of a violation shall be deemed a separate offense;

SECTION 6: This ordinance being necessary to enhance the collection and removal of solid waste to enforce the contract for same and payment for the collection of said solid waste, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
