

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-3**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED:

“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2004-6 Art. 7, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”


Section 1. Ozark City Ordinance No. 2004-6, Article 7, (C) (10) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(10) Temporary and Political Signs. Political, community, civic and fraternal organizations may place signs of a temporary nature on private property with the permission of the land owner, provided however, that such signs may not, in the case of political signs, be placed more than sixty (60) days prior to the election in which votes will be cast in such race. In the case of community, civic and fraternal organization signs, such signs shall not be placed more than sixty (60) days prior to the event being advertised, or if no particular event is advertised, for no more than sixty (60) days total. A violation of this section shall constitute a violation and shall be punishable, upon a finding of guilty, by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Each day shall constitute a separate offense.
