BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED:

“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2021-3, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”


Section 1. Ordinance No. 2021-3, Section (1)(A)(b) is stricken and shall read hereafter as follows: “An employee has tested positive for COVID-19 or any variant by testing at any regular or specially set up COVID testing medical facility. Home tests shall not be recognized for ascertaining administrative leave entitlement.”

Section 2. Ordinance No. 2021-3, Section (4)(a) is stricken and shall read hereafter as follows: “Evidence of a positive COVID-19 test by testing at any regular or specially set up COVID testing medical facility. Home tests shall not be recognized for ascertaining administrative leave entitlement.”

Section 3. This Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
