**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO'S 1992-14 AND 1997-20;
SETTING NEW WATER RATES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
THEREFORE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK,
ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The current water rates are in need of modification to meet new and additional expenses.

SECTION 2: All existing water rates for wholesale water purchasers shall be increased by twelve percent (12%). The new rate shall be rounded to the nearest whole cent. The increase in rates shall take effect January 1, 2004. The existing rates were set by Ordinance No. 1997-20 and said rates took effect on January 1, 1998. All such rates shall be increased on the effective date by the amount of 12%, rounded to the nearest whole cent.


SECTION 3: It being necessary for the proper funding of the Ozark water system and for the preservation of the public health, safety, peace and welfare, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK,
ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The current water rates are in need of modification to meet new and additional expenses.

SECTION 2: All existing water rates for wholesale water purchasers shall be increased by twelve percent (12%). The new rate shall be rounded to the nearest whole cent. The increase in rates shall take effect January 1, 2004. The existing rates were set by Ordinance No. 1997-20 and said rates took effect on January 1, 1998. SECTION 3: It being necessary for the proper funding of the Ozark water system and for the preservation of the public health, safety, peace and welfare, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage.
