

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-14

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING PROCESS FOR REPAIR OF 13TH STREET, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS, THAT:

I.

Arkansas Code Annotated 18-58-303 and City of Ozark Ordinance No. 1995-12 require competitive bidding, but allow the City Council, by ordinance, to waive competitive bidding in instances where it is not practical or feasible to accept bids.

II

The City Council deems it not practical nor feasible to advertise for or accept competitive bids for the repair of 13th street. That the City has been given a quote for the said repair of \$25,300.00 for the tearing out of existing culverts and building concrete boxes all as per proposal, attached hereto as Attachment "A" and incorporated herein by reference, all by Clint Johnson with J&E Construction. Considering the necessity for the scheduled street closing and the inconvenience thereby, the Mayor should be, and hereby is, authorized to contract with J&E Construction on said quote in order to provide for the above referenced job to be completed in a timely manner.

III.


It being necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
