


AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2002-2 ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS ON OR ALONG STATE OR FEDERAL HIGHWAYS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OZARK, AR CITY COUNCIL THAT:

SECTION 1: The Ordinance No. 2002-2 prohibiting parking on or along state or federal highways and setting out fines and penalties therefor, is hereby repealed.



ORDINANCE NO. 2002-2

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS ON OR ALONG STATE OR FEDERAL HIGHWAYS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFORE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The City of Ozark does hereby establish a parking prohibition, prohibiting parking on or along state or federal highways unless specifically allowed by posted signs or allowed by painted markings on the highway surface.

SECTION 2: Vehicles parked illegally and in violation of this prohibition shall be subject to fines and penalties as set forth in the City of Ozark Parking Ordinance, Ordinance No. 280.


