

ORDINANCE NO. 1999-19

**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR TRASH TRUCK;  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFORE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS  
THAT:

I.

Arkansas Code Ann. §18-58-303 and City of Ozark Ordinance No. 1995-12 require competitive bidding, but allow the City Council by ordinance to waive competitive bidding in instances where it is not practical or feasible to accept bids.


II.

The City Council deems it not practical nor feasible to advertise for and accept competitive bids for the purchase of a Heil rear-load trash truck. The City has received a quote from River City Hydraulics, Inc. of North Little Rock, Arkansas for the sum and amount of \$86,876.00. River City Hydraulics, Inc. is able to supply the truck within two weeks as opposed to a much longer delay. In light of the detriment which would be placed upon the City to further delay the delivery of a trash truck, and in light of River City Hydraulics, Inc. being the only in-state supplier of the Heil trash truck which can thus handle warranty claims and repairs in a more expedient fashion, the Mayor should be and hereby is authorized to contract with River City Hydraulics, Inc. to purchase said truck.

III.

It being necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
